On October 6th, 2021, Minister Monte McNaughton, Minister of Labour, Training and Skills Development that: "Ontario's Workplace Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB) is cutting premium rates in 2022 by \$168 million, bringing the total reduction in premiums since 2018 to \$2.4 billion. In addition, the government is intending to introduce legislation that, if passed, would allow for a significant portion of the WSIB's current reserve, currently valued at \$6.1 billion, to be distributed to safe employers. This proposed change would help employers cope with the impacts of COVID-19." Ontario news release.'

What does this mean for your trucking company? This means that finally, safety is being put forward, and your hard work to keep your employees safe can have a positive financial and WSIB insurance rate on your workplace.

"The average rate will be \$1.30, down from \$1.37, per \$100 of insurable payroll. Trucking's rate will be \$4.03, down 5.6% from \$4.27 the past two years." Trucknews.com

Falls are a leading cause of truck driver injuries **Safe work practices for drivers**

Falls from height are a leading cause of injury for commercial drivers. Jumping from cabs and trailer decks can result in serious injuries.

trucknews.com

For truckers, slips, trips, and falls cause over 30% of all work-related injuries and 50% of these injuries are critical injuries. Over the next few months, you should be particularly careful, since typically, more than half of these falls occur during the winter season.

These falls are costly. A recent North American study shows that each trucker who reports a fall injury will lose an average of 19 work days. As well, one third of all fall injuries are so severe that the trucker requires 29 days off work, significantly impacting an injured trucker's health and income.

Although truck drivers and delivery workers are exposed to a number of traffic-related hazards every day, one hazard that may not be apparent is the risk of falling from a vehicle.


